

Supplier's Declaration Conflict minerals - Dodd-Frank-Act, Section 1502

Stäubli Electrical Connectors (hereinafter referred to as "STÄUBLI") is aware of Dodd-Frank-Act, Section 1502 concerning conflict minerals. STÄUBLI has every intention to contribute to the continuing process for obtaining a cleaner and healthier environment and the ethical responsibility. We are continuously improving our products and processes.

Under Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Act, publicly traded companies in the U.S. must eliminate the use of

- Tin
- Tungsten
- Tantalum
- Gold

in their products and conduct due diligence to trace the origin of the minerals.

We do not directly process any of the materials listed. Because our supply chains are complex, we have actively asked our suppliers to provide us with information about the origin of the materials we use. As a result of the dialogue with our suppliers, we currently have no reason to believe that the raw materials used in our products could originate from the crisis regions mentioned.

We therefore declare all minerals processed by us to be "conflict-free" within the meaning of the Dodd-Frank Act.
